For your final project in Spanish IV, you will write, develop, and direct a cortometraje. This project is complex and a huge component of your grade, so pay attention to the procedures:

First, find a partner or two and develop a theme. Is it going to be romantic, a crime drama, a comedy.? Your initial idea will be due by the end of next class.

Second, you need to compose a script. Everyone in your group is going to need to be a character and have lines. Your script should be about 10 minutes in length, which is significant. In addition to the script composition, you will need to turn in a list of all words that you have looked up for the development of the script and the movie. This “vocabulary list” should have the Spanish words and the corresponding English ones. If you have a word in your script that is not in your vocabulary list, you will lose points. The development of the script is most likely going to be the most time of the entire project.

Third, you need to film your cortometraje. You aren’t really being graded in your acting abilities, nor in your directing or editing abilities. However, a large component of this assignment is going to be “How impressive was the film?,” so make sure you are doing what you can to impress me. These will be due on \_\_\_\_\_.
